Hard Hats

All Juniors, when riding anywhere on the show grounds, must wear protective headgear which meets USEF standards. Any rider violating this rule will be prohibited from riding until his or her headgear is properly in place. Adults are required to wear hard hats.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Entries mailed or faxed must be received by 9:00 pm Friday the 21st or Day Of Show Fees will be charged. No money need be sent in advance. On the day of show make any changes before picking up your number. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. Classes may **NOT** be added at the gate. You must add in the office. If you find you can not come to the show after entering, call the show office at 303-841-7461. After picking up your number there will be no refunds without a veterinary certificate.

SCHOOLING

A limited number of horses will be allowed in the arena at one time. Schooling on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting. Schooling will be permitted from 6:30am until 30 minutes prior to the start of each ring.

RETURNED CHECKS

There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or cash equivalent.

AWARDS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

First place trophy and ribbons to sixth place. Division championships will be awarded.

The Press Release Perpetual Trophy

Donated by Sherry, Jon and Lili Faye McNaulty

This special award will be awarded to the adult amateur rider who earns the most points on one horse in the following divisions. CHJA Amateur Hunter, CHJA Adult Jumper, CHJA Adult Eq. The points from the JR/AA Jumper and Hunter Classics will also count. To be eligible, a rider must show the same horse in any or all eligible divisions. The winner will receive the Press Release Perpetual Trophy to be engraved by the winner. There will be a keeper trophy awarded.

Red/Blue Warm up - Open to all horses and ponies. Fences will change with division heights. Courses may be changed or adjusted during the show. Warm up may be closed during flat classes and during some classes which will be announced. PLEASE pay attention to the warm up close announcements. Horses and ponies will be judged and given a numeric score. A score of 80-100 will earn a blue award. Scores from 70-79 will earn a red award.

Class 102 \$250 Judy Silver Memorial Beginner Junior/Amateur Hunter Classic The first round of the classic is class 39 or 42. The second round of the classic may be ridden immediately after your first round. Entry fee \$40.

Class 106 Jr/AA Equitation Classic - Scores from both rounds of the o/f classes of Sunday's Eq divisions will be combined to form a score for the Classic. Be sure to enter the Classics prior to the start of your equitation division. Classes to count 57 & 100, 58 & 94. Entry fee \$10.

Class 107 MRC Equitation Classic - Scores from both rounds of the o/f classes of CHJA 11&U and CHJA Pony Eq divisions will be combined to form a score for the Classic. Be sure to enter the Classics prior to the start of your equitation division. Classes to count 52 & 89, 83 & 84. Entry fee \$10.
