SHOW RULES

Entries will be accepted on the day of show. However, a \$25.00 day of show penalty will apply.

Fees:

- Regular classes \$17.00
- Medal Classes \$20.00
- Equitation Classics \$15.00
- Day of Show Penalty \$25.00
- EMT Fee \$15.00 per rider
- Office Fee \$15.00 per entry
- Stalls \$30.00/day
- Grounds Fee \$15.00 non-stabled horses

1. All fees should be made payable to: **MRC Horse Show** Mail to: Carole A. Kenney, 213 Birch Ave, Castle Rock, CO 80104.
2. **No refunds will be given unless accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate.**
3. Stalls will be available for a fee of \$30.00 per show day. The stalls will not be bedded. Bedding may be available, please call to reserve. Carole - 303-840-4384

Regulations:

1. Back to back rounds allowed and encouraged.
2. No-judges will be allowed.
3. Hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while on Colorado Horse Park property.
4. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 6:30 am until 30 minutes prior to the start of the ring. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if other horses are waiting.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class(es) should it be in the best interest of the show.
6. Only one horse per entry form.
7. A one minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management in order to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring.
8. Each class will award a first place trophy and ribbons through sixth place.
9. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
10. There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to be paid in full by cash or equivalent.
11. Pets must be on a leash at all times! Dogs found loose on the property will be picked up by Douglas County Animal Control. Fines start at \$90.00.

ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entries must be received by 9:00 pm Friday the 1st or Day Of Show Fees will be charged. On the day of show make any changes before picking up your number. After picking up your number you are financially responsible for your entries. No extra charge for adding classes as long as you add them prior to riding in the class. Classes may **NOT** be added at the gate. You must add in the office.

Red/Blue Warmup - Open to all horses and ponies. Fences will change with division heights. Courses may be changed or adjusted during the show. Warmup may be closed during flat classes and during some classes which will be announced. PLEASE pay attention to the Warmup close announcements. Horses and ponies will be judged and given a numeric score. A score of 80-100 will earn a blue award. Scores from 70-79 will earn a red award.

Class 102 Meridian Farms Beginner Equitation Classic - Scores from two rounds of the over fences classes of Beginner Equitation Divisions will be combined to form a score for the classic. Be sure to enter the classic prior to the start of your equitation division.

Classes to count: 7, 11, 27, 28, 29, 30, 38, 41 Entry Fee \$15.00

Class 103 Rocky Mountain Riding Academy Equitation Classic - Scores from two rounds of the over fences classes of Saturday's CHJA 11 & U and CHJA Pony Equitation Divisions will be combined to form a score for the classic. Be sure to enter the classic prior to the start of your equitation division. Classes to count: 52, 83, 84, 89 Entry Fee \$15.00

Class 104 Meridian Riding Club Junior/AA Equitation Classic - Scores from two rounds of the over fences classes of Sunday's Equitation Divisions will be combined to form a score for the classic. Be sure to enter the classic prior to the start of your equitation division.

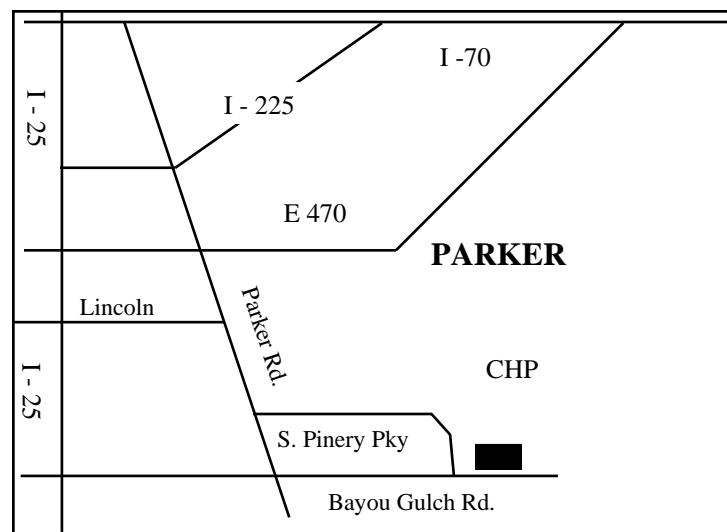
