Entries are limited. No entries will be accepted post marked earlier than February 25, 2010. Entries MUST be complete including full payment. In the event that we reach our entry limit, we will maintain a waiting list and move people up the list by postmark. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Confirmation letters will be mailed (for those who do not include an e-mail address) or sent via e-mail. No refunds after April 25, 2010.

There will be no payback for Nursery! Limited Entries – 2 dogs per class (no dog entered in more than one class unless entries do not fill)
Entries limited to the first 60 dogs each day Saturday – Sunday - Monday

2010 Entry Guidelines & Information

1. **ENTRIES** – Entries will open, **February 25, 2010**, and will close **April 25, 2010**.
 - Entries must be mailed to: DMT Enterprises, Inc., **Attn: Deborah M. Terry, Trial Director, 1382 Flintwood Road, Franktown, CO 80116;**
 - No Faxed or hand delivered entries will be accepted;
 - Entries may not be postmarked prior to, **February 25, 2010**. Entries postmarked before entries open will go to the bottom of the entry waiting list.
 - Entries will be prioritized **FIRST** by postmark date, and subsequent priority (waiting list) will be decided by a random drawing for each postmark day. The drawing will be done by household not by entry envelope;
 - Handlers will be notified of their accepted entry (first 60 dogs each day) or their spot on the waiting list. Please include an e-mail address and/or fax number where information can be sent.
2. **ENTRY CHECKS** – All entry checks received with valid entries will be cashed upon receipt. At any time on or before April 25, 2010 handlers may request a refund. Refund checks will be mailed with in 15 days of request less a \$5.00 office fee, to cover processing and postage of refund, effectively scratching their dog(s) or removing themselves from the waiting list.
3. **LIMIT 60 DOGS EACH DAY** – Each handler may enter as many as two (2) dogs per division.
4. **SCRATCHES** – Refunds are issued for scratches **ONLY** if Trial Director is notified by April 25, 2010.
5. **SUBSTITUTIONS** –
 - Handlers may make substitutions by notifying the Trial Director on or before April 25, 2010 by calling 303-688-3266 or e-mailing dmtevents@msn.com;
 - Only in the case of death or veterinary emergency will **EMERGENCY SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS** be entertained from **April 26, 2010 to May 20, 2010 before 6:00 p.m.;**
 - **EMERGENCY SUBSTITUTION REQUESTS** must be accompanied by a veterinarian's affidavit, clearly stating the reason the entered dog is unable to run.
 - A dog may be scratched only once, and after that the dog may **NOT** run.
6. **DRAW** – A legal draw will be done according to USBCHA guidelines on May 1, 2010, and posted on MPBCA web site thereafter. Running Order disputes will be resolved by Judge's discretion.
7. **WAITING LIST** – Handler's meeting the entry deadline, but not making the draw (first 60) will remain on a waiting list until 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 26, 2010. Waiting handlers will be prioritized **FIRST** by postmark date. Subsequent priority will be decided by a random draw for each postmark day/lot. The drawing will be done by household **NOT** by entry envelope. Waiting list Handlers will be notified of their eligibility for the running by the trial director. Waiting handlers not making the draw will receive full entry refunds, after the trial.
8. **LAST MINUTE ENTRY PROVISION** – In the event that there are open slots in the run order after the Waiting List has been exhausted, the Trial Director will accept last minute cash entries. Eligible handlers/dogs for Last Minute Entries are:
 - Handlers with two (or fewer) entered dogs;
 - Handlers must be present, in person or by proxy, to enter (at trial site 5:00 p.m. Friday May 28, 2010);
 - Handler must complete entry form and submit fees in full;
 - Handlers are limited to two (2) additional dog entries;
 - Last Minute Entry dogs will have to run in the open slot for which they are drawn.
9. **TIE BREAKERS** – If two or more competitors stand equal in points, the judge will settle their priority by (1st) their combined points for the outrun, lift and fetch, (2nd) by each subsequent phase of the trial i.e., the drive, shed & pen, and (3rd) by going back to the individual points of the outrun, then the lift, then the fetch.
10. **PAYBACK CHECKS** – will be determined by the number of entries and mailed to Handlers with in 30 days of the Trial to the address on the entry form.
11. DMT Enterprises, Inc. reserves the right to review special circumstances as they arise.
