### **1) ENTRIES:**

Entry fees include \$25 non-refundable office fee.

Entries postmarked after C.D. require \$25 late fee

Double entries: Not accepted.

YOUNG HORSE Entries - All horses in these classes must be registered with USEA and their breed association.

Checks and credit card charges will be processed upon entry acceptance.

National Passports required for all FOREIGN-owned CCI horses. The FEI passport is not required this year if competing in your home country.

All US-owned, non-passport holding CCI1\* horses must have identification of horse (i.e., Coggins) AND a certificate of vaccination against influenza, signed by their veterinarian, stating that entered horse has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza, given between 1 and 3 months apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given within each SIX months, subsequent to the second injection of the primary vaccination. None of these injections must have been given within the preceding 7 days, including the day of the competition or entry into the competition stables.

The above are the minimum requirements for influenza vaccination. Both primary and first and subsequent booster injections should be given according to the manufacturer's instructions, which will fall within the stipulation of the FEI Veterinary Regulations.

CCI horses arriving w/o correct up-to-date vaccination records in accordance w/ FEI Vet Regs, Appendix VI, will be charged additional \$100.00 office fee.

CCI1\* riders must include copy of medical armband w/ entry.

All CCI1\* Riders & Horses must be registered with FEI, USEF, USEA

All Prelim and CCI1\* must include copy of USEF member card for rider and owner w/ entry

Refunds: Before C.D.-Less \$25 non-refundable office fee; After C.D.- Entry credit only to next event until May 28. After May 28 - No refunds.

ALL SCRATCHES / CHANGES MUST BE IN WRITING, EMAIL OR FAX.- \$25 FEE for any changes after C.D., subject to availability of slots in other divisions  
Competition cancellation-No refund.

Neg. Coggins required within 12 months for all horses (state law). Copy of Coggins must accompany entry
